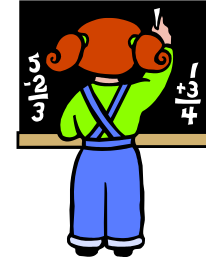
4K PROGRAMS

Our 4K programs are available to students who turn 4 years of age on or before September 1st of the upcoming school year. We offer two 4K programming options for parents. There is a half day option and a full day option.

HALF DAY 4K PROGRAM

- Children participate in either a morning or afternoon session of 4K.
- Morning session times are 7:55am-11:15am.
- Afternoon session times are 12:25pm-3:36pm.
- Both morning and afternoon sessions meet M, T, W, R, F of each week (following school calendar).
- Transportation is available at 7:55am and 3:36pm with the regular school district bussing. There is no bussing or transportation available at the 11:15am or 12:25pm times. This is the responsibility of the parents.

Option availability is contingent upon the number of students interested in the program.



FULL DAY 4K PROGRAM

- Children participate in a full day of school (7:55am-3:36pm).
- Programming is a mixture of 4K and child care activities (example: 50 minute block with 4K teacher, 50 minute block with child care teacher).
- Full day 4K meets M, T, W, R, F or each week (following school calendar).
- Students have the option of eating breakfast & lunch at school (provided that accounts are kept current) or bringing their own lunch.
- Students have rest time during their time at school.
- Transportation is available at both the 7:55am start and the 3:36pm dismissal.

Option availability is contingent upon the number of students interested in the program.
