- B. Disscussion on TID's. Drew Johnson asked City Reps if there was any chance of a compromise plan. The response was no, but Aaron Kramer (City Administrator) "Aaron stated that he could not put those promises in writing as it would not be binding, but as long as he was around his word was good." (points 2, 3, and 4 below were read and agreed to being accurate by Aaron Kramer and the city council members that were present) The board members present were split over how to recommend Mr. Johnson to vote. Atkins and Achenbach felt that he should vote "NO", Rutherford and Ruskey felt "YES". No motion could be made that would pass either way. So the consensus was to have Mr. Johnson go to the meeting and abstain.
 - 1. The reasoning is that the board members that were present were split and no motion could be made that would pass either way.
 - 2. In addition, Aaron Kramer told the Board that there was no intention of transferring more than the deficit amount of less than \$300,000.
 - 3. Unless there would be a future large development that would need a sizable amount of seed dollars, the TID 6 would not be extended past its original date anyway.
 - 4. Aaron stated that the only reason the large amounts are in the resolution is that the maximums available to be spent have to be included by state law, but there is no intention of using those maximum amount of funds.
